



Horizon 2020: New strategy for international cooperation in research and innovation



Three main objectives:

- Strengthen the Union's excellence and attractiveness in research and innovation as well as its industrial and economic competitiveness;
- Tackle global societal challenges;
- Support the Union's external policies.



International Cooperation in Horizon 2020

General opening (automatic funding also to ICPC countries, but not any more to BRIC + Mexico)

Targeted activities in Societal Challenges and Industrial Leadership
Projects with required or preferential 3rd country participation
joint calls, multi-lateral activities, ERA-NETs

Excellent Science


Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellowships: strong international dimension Development of global research infrastructures (Carnegie Group-CA, JP, RU,US)

ERC open to researchers from all over the world - research to be carried out mostly in Member States or Associated Countries

- Dedicated cross-cutting actions Inclusive, Innovative and Secure Societies challenge
 - Support for to policy dialogue
 - Networking and twinning activities
 - Coordination of EU and MS/AC international cooperation policies
 - Strengthening of European presence in international partner countries



How to better participate in H2020

- Consider being a partner in a consortium
- Read Work Programme carefully
- Formulate your role in a project
 - Based on your expertise
- Contact your former partners
- Try to find new partners
- Do yourself visible and attractive



Read Work Programme carefully

- Work programme follows the evaluation criteria
- Proposers are offered sufficient flexibility and freedom of choice
- Careful reader of the work programme should get a clear message of needs and expectations



Formulate your role in a project:

Group A

Has project idea and would like to be the **coordinator**

Group B

Has project **idea** but does not want to be the coordinator

Group C

Does not have an idea but would like to be beneficiary



If you have a project idea and you would like to be the coordinator

- Analyse the needs of your project: Try to find the BEST partners
- Your partner should
 - be eligible
 - answer the needs of your project
 - have complementary skills
 - produce an added value for the project
- Where and how you can find the best partner?
 - Screen you own existing international contacts
 - Use the network of national contact points
 - Publish or disseminate your partner search
 - Attend information days, brokerage events etc



If you have a project idea but you do not want to be the coordinator

Define clearly your project idea and try to find the MOST EXPERIENCED coordinator & consortium

- Again check the eligibility criteria (type of the institution, geography...)
- Screen the former coordinators
- Screen you own existing international contacts
- Use the network of national contact points
- Attend information days, brokerage events
- Screen best practices



If you do not have an idea but you would like to be a beneficiary

- Describe yourself : **MOTIVATION LETTER**
 - Check if you are eligible for the call
 - Try to find the coordinators, call your friends & colleagues
 - Define: your potential contributions to the project and the consortium
 - Screen the existing projects
- and again...
 - Screen you own existing international contacts
 - Use the network of national contact points (partner profile tools)
 - Publish your profile




Do yourself visible and attractive

 - among friends




